

Directions to Cabins of Birch Hollow

170 Birch Hollow Road, Stanton, KY 40380

Directions from Cincinnati, OH, or Knoxville, TN via I-75, or from Louisville, KY via I-64 E:

If you are driving from any of the three locations above, you will be heading to Lexington, KY, where I-75 intersects I-64 East.

1. Starting at the intersection of I-75 South and I-64 East, head East on I-64 for approximately 16 miles to Exit 98, which is the Bert T. Combs Mountain Parkway, or Route 402. Signs at Exit 98 show that you are headed toward Stanton, Campton, Prestonsburg, and Natural Bridge State Resort Park.
2. Drive about 22 miles to Exit 22 (Stanton, KY), or Route 213.
3. When you come to the light just off Exit 22, turn left onto Main Street and drive to the 2nd light, then turn right onto Route 11 & 15 (E College Ave).
4. Drive about 8.5 miles to Route 1639 (South Fork Road) and turn right onto Route 1639.
5. Drive 1.3 miles on Route 1639 to Birch Hollow Road on your right. You will see our sign and logo at the entrance.
6. Drive approximately 500 feet to the mailboxes on your left. The first large, black one has the address on it and is a regular mailbox. Just past it you will see two smaller mailboxes – one is white (Check In) and one is black (Drop Box).
7. Open the white (Check In) mailbox and look for an envelope with your name and cabin name on it. Open the envelope to read and sign the rental agreement if you haven't already sent it to us and to get a map directing you to your cabin in the Hollow. Put the signed rental agreement into the slot in the black mailbox (Drop Box).
8. If you ordered firewood, there will also be a smaller envelope in the white mailbox for you to use to leave cash for firewood. Put the firewood envelope with cash into the slot in the black mailbox, too.

Directions from Ashland, KY, or Huntington or Charleston, WV via I-64 W:

If you are driving from any of the locations above, you will be heading west *toward* Lexington, KY, on I-64 W, but your goal is to get to Exit 98 on I-64 E. Since there is no westbound Exit 98 to put you *directly* on the Bert T. Combs Mountain Parkway, you will instead need make a U-turn to get onto I-64 E, and here's how to do that:

1. Drive on I-64 W to Exit 95, Route 627, turn left onto Route 627, and look for the ramp to get back on I-64 E.
2. Once on I-64 E, drive to Exit 98, which is the Bert T. Combs Mountain Parkway, or Route 402. Signs at Exit 98 show that you are headed to the Stanton, Campton, Prestonsburg, and Natural Bridge State Resort Park.

3. Drive about 22 miles to Exit 22 (Stanton, KY), or Route 213.
4. When you come to the light just off Exit 22, turn left onto Main Street and drive to the 2nd light, then turn right onto Route 11 & 15 (E College Ave).
5. Drive about 8.5 miles to Route 1639 (South Fork Road) and turn right onto Route 1639.
6. Drive 1.3 miles on Route 1639 to Birch Hollow Road on your right. You will see our sign and logo at the entrance.
7. Drive approximately 500 feet to the mailboxes on your left. The first large, black one has the address on it and is a regular mailbox. Just past it you will see two smaller mailboxes – one is white (Check In) and one is black (Drop Box).
8. Open the white (Check In) mailbox and look for an envelope with your name and cabin name on it. Directions from Prestonsburg or Pikesville or Hazard, KY:

1. Get on the Mountain Parkway, Route 15, heading northwest *toward* Lexington, KY.
2. Take Exit 33, which is Slade, KY, and turn right.
3. Drive to the stop sign and turn left on Route 11/15, or Campton Rd.
4. Drive 4.3 miles to Route 1639 (South Fork Rd). Turn left onto Route 1639.
5. Drive 1.3 miles on Route 1639 to Birch Hollow Road on your right. You will see our sign and logo at the entrance.
6. Drive approximately 500 feet to the mailboxes on your left. The first large, black one has the address on it and is a regular mailbox. Just past it you will see two smaller mailboxes – one is white (Check In) and one is black (Drop Box).
7. Open the white (Check In) mailbox and look for an envelope with your name and cabin name on it. Open the envelope to read and sign the rental agreement if you haven't already sent it to us and to get a map directing you to your cabin in the Hollow. Put the signed rental agreement into the slot in the black mailbox (Drop Box).
